Psalm 1

1. Psalm 1:1 Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful;
2. Psalm 1:2 But his delight is in the law of the Lord, And in His law he meditates day and night.
3. Psalm 1:3 He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper.
4. Psalm 1:4 The ungodly are not so, But are like the chaff which the wind drives away.
5. Psalm 1:5 Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, Nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.
6. Psalm 1:6 For the Lord knows the way of the righteous, But the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Psalm 2

7. Psalm 2:1 Why do the nations rage, And the people plot a vain thing?
8. Psalm 2:2 The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, Against the Lord and against His Anointed, saying,
9. Psalm 2:3 "Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us."
10. Psalm 2:4 He who sits in the heavens shall laugh; The Lord shall hold them in derision.
11. Psalm 2:5 Then He shall speak to them in His wrath, And distress them in His deep displeasure:
12. Psalm 2:6 "Yet I have set My King On My holy hill of Zion."
13. Psalm 2:7 "I will declare the decree: The Lord has said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You.
14. Psalm 2:8 Ask of Me, and I will give You The nations for Your inheritance, And the ends of the earth for Your possession.
15. Psalm 2:9 You shall break them with a rod of iron; You shall dash them to pieces like a potter's vessel.' "
16. Psalm 2:10 Now therefore, be wise, O kings; Be instructed, you judges of the earth.
17. Psalm 2:11 Serve the Lord with fear, And rejoice with trembling.
18. Psalm 2:12 Kiss the Son, lest He be angry, And you perish in the way, When His wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all those who put their trust in Him.

Psalm 3

19. Psalm 3:1 Lord, how they have increased who trouble me! Many are they who rise up against me.
20. Psalm 3:2 Many are they who say of me, "There is no help for him in God."

21. Psalm 3:3 But You, O Lord, are a shield for me, My glory and the One who lifts up my head.
22. Psalm 3:4 I cried to the Lord with my voice, And He heard me from His holy hill.
23. Psalm 3:5 I lay down and slept; I awoke, for the Lord sustained me.
24. Psalm 3:6 I will not be afraid of ten thousands of people Who have set themselves against me all around.
25. Psalm 3:7 Arise, O Lord; Save me, O my God! For You have struck all my enemies on the cheekbone; You have broken the teeth of the ungodly.
26. Psalm 3:8 Salvation belongs to the Lord. Your blessing is upon Your people.

Psalm 4

27. Psalm 4:1 Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have relieved me in my distress; Have mercy on me, and hear my prayer.
28. Psalm 4:2 How long, O you sons of men, Will you turn my glory to shame? How long will you love worthlessness And seek falsehood?
29. Psalm 4:3 But know that the Lord has set apart for Himself him who is godly; The Lord will hear when I call to Him.
30. Psalm 4:4 Be angry, and do not sin. Meditate within your heart on your bed, and be still.
31. Psalm 4:5 Offer the sacrifices of righteousness, And put your trust in the Lord.
32. Psalm 4:6 There are many who say, "Who will show us any good?" Lord, lift up the light of Your countenance upon us.
33. Psalm 4:7 You have put gladness in my heart, More than in the season that their grain and wine increased.
34. Psalm 4:8 I will both lie down in peace, and sleep; For You alone, O Lord, make me dwell in safety.

Psalm 5

35. Psalm 5:1 Give ear to my words, O Lord, Consider my meditation.
36. Psalm 5:2 Give heed to the voice of my cry, My King and my God, For to You I will pray.
37. Psalm 5:3 My voice You shall hear in the morning, O Lord; In the morning I will direct it to You, And I will look up.
38. Psalm 5:4 For You are not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness, Nor shall evil dwell with You.
39. Psalm 5:5 The boastful shall not stand in Your sight; You hate all workers of iniquity.
40. Psalm 5:6 You shall destroy those who speak falsehood; The Lord abhors the bloodthirsty and deceitful man.
41. Psalm 5:7 But as for me, I will come into Your house in the multitude of Your mercy; In fear of You I will worship toward Your holy temple.
42. Psalm 5:8 Lead me, O Lord, in Your righteousness because of my enemies; Make Your way straight before my face.
43. Psalm 5:9 For there is no faithfulness in their mouth; Their inward part is destruction; Their throat is an open tomb; They flatter with their tongue.
44. Psalm 5:10 Pronounce them guilty, O God! Let them fall by their own counsels; Cast them out in the multitude of their transgressions, For they have rebelled against You
45. Psalm 5:11 But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; Let those also who love Your name Be joyful in You
46. Psalm 5:12 For You, O Lord, will bless the righteous; With favor You will surround him as with a shield.

Psalm 6

47. Psalm 6:1 O Lord, do not rebuke me in Your anger, Nor chasten me in Your hot displeasure.
48. Psalm 6:2 Have mercy on me, O Lord, for I am weak; O Lord, heal me, for my bones are troubled.
49. Psalm 6:3 My soul also is greatly troubled; But You, O Lord--how long?
50. Psalm 6:4 Return, O Lord, deliver me! Oh, save me for Your mercies' sake!
51. Psalm 6:5 For in death there is no remembrance of You; In the grave who will give You thanks?
52. Psalm 6:6 I am weary with my groaning; All night I make my bed swim; I drench my couch with my tears.
53. Psalm 6:7 My eye wastes away because of grief; It grows old because of all my enemies.
54. Psalm 6:8 Depart from me, all you workers of iniquity; For the Lord has heard the voice of my weeping.
55. Psalm 6:9 The Lord has heard my supplication; The Lord will receive my prayer.
56. Psalm 6:10 Let all my enemies be ashamed and greatly troubled; Let them turn back and be ashamed suddenly.

Psalm 7

57. Psalm 7:1 O Lord my God, in You I put my trust; Save me from all those who persecute me; And deliver me,
58. Psalm 7:2 Lest they tear me like a lion, Rending me in pieces, while there is none to deliver.
59. Psalm 7:3 O Lord my God, if I have done this: If there is iniquity in my hands,
60. Psalm 7:4 If I have repaid evil to him who was at peace with me, Or have plundered my enemy without cause,
61. Psalm 7:5 Let the enemy pursue me and overtake me; Yes, let him trample my life to the earth, And lay my honor in the dust.
62. Psalm 7:6 Arise, O Lord, in Your anger; Lift Yourself up because of the rage of my enemies; Rise up for me to the judgment You have commanded!
63. Psalm 7:7 So the congregation of the peoples shall surround You; For their sakes, therefore, return on high.
64. Psalm 7:8 The Lord shall judge the peoples; Judge me, O Lord, according to my righteousness, And according to my integrity within me.
65. Psalm 7:9 Oh, let the wickedness of the wicked come to an end, But establish the just; For the righteous God tests the hearts and minds.
66. Psalm 7:10 My defense is of God, Who saves the upright in heart.
67. Psalm 7:11 God is a just judge, And God is angry with the wicked every day.
68. Psalm 7:12 If he does not turn back, He will sharpen His sword; He bends His bow and makes it ready.
69. Psalm 7:13 He also prepares for Himself instruments of death; He makes His arrows into fiery shafts.
70. Psalm 7:14 Behold, the wicked brings forth iniquity; Yes, he conceives trouble and brings forth falsehood.
71. Psalm 7:15 He made a pit and dug it out, And has fallen into the ditch which he made.
72. Psalm 7:16 His trouble shall return upon his own head, And his violent dealing shall come down on his own crown.
73. Psalm 7:17 I will praise the Lord according to His righteousness, And will sing praise to the name of the Lord Most High.

Psalm 8

74. Psalm 8:1 O Lord, our Lord, How excellent is Your name in all the earth, Who have set Your glory above the heavens!

75. Psalm 8:2 Out of the mouth of babes and nursing infants You have ordained strength, Because of Your enemies, That You may silence the enemy and the avenger.
76. Psalm 8:3 When I consider Your heavens, the work of Your fingers, The moon and the stars, which You have ordained,
77. Psalm 8:4 What is man that You are mindful of him, And the son of man that You visit him?
78. Psalm 8:5 For You have made him a little lower than the angels, And You have crowned him with glory and honor.
79. Psalm 8:6 You have made him to have dominion over the works of Your hands; You have put all things under his feet,
80. Psalm 8:7 All sheep and oxen-- Even the beasts of the field,
81. Psalm 8:8 The birds of the air, And the fish of the sea That pass through the paths of the seas.
82. Psalm 8:9 O Lord, our Lord, How excellent is Your name in all the earth!

Psalm 9

83. Psalm 9:1 I will praise You, O Lord, with my whole heart; I will tell of all Your marvelous works.
84. Psalm 9:2 I will be glad and rejoice in You; I will sing praise to Your name, O Most High.
85. Psalm 9:3 When my enemies turn back, They shall fall and perish at Your presence.
86. Psalm 9:4 For You have maintained my right and my cause; You sat on the throne judging in righteousness.
87. Psalm 9:5 You have rebuked the nations, You have destroyed the wicked; You have blotted out their name forever and ever.
88. Psalm 9:6 O enemy, destructions are finished forever! And you have destroyed cities; Even their memory has perished.
89. Psalm 9:7 But the Lord shall endure forever; He has prepared His throne for judgment.
90. Psalm 9:8 He shall judge the world in righteousness, And He shall administer judgment for the peoples in uprightness.
91. Psalm 9:9 The Lord also will be a refuge for the oppressed, A refuge in times of trouble.
92. Psalm 9:10 And those who know Your name will put their trust in You; For You, Lord, have not forsaken those who seek You.
93. Psalm 9:11 Sing praises to the Lord, who dwells in Zion! Declare His deeds among the people.
94. Psalm 9:12 When He avenges blood, He remembers them; He does not forget the cry of the humble.
95. Psalm 9:13 Have mercy on me, O Lord! Consider my trouble from those who hate me, You who lift me up from the gates of death,
96. Psalm 9:14 That I may tell of all Your praise In the gates of the daughter of Zion. I will rejoice in Your salvation.
97. Psalm 9:15 The nations have sunk down in the pit which they made; In the net which they hid, their own foot is caught.
98. Psalm 9:16 The Lord is known by the judgment He executes; The wicked is snared in the work of his own hands. Meditation.
99. Psalm 9:17 The wicked shall be turned into hell, And all the nations that forget God.
100. Psalm 9:18 For the needy shall not always be forgotten; The expectation of the poor shall not perish forever.
101. Psalm 9:19 Arise, O Lord, Do not let man prevail; Let the nations be judged in Your sight.

102. Psalm 9:20 Put them in fear, O Lord, That the nations may know themselves to be but men.

Psalm 10

103. Psalm 10:1 Why do You stand afar off, O Lord? Why do You hide in times of trouble?
104. Psalm 10:2 The wicked in his pride persecutes the poor; Let them be caught in the plots which they have devised.
105. Psalm 10:3 For the wicked boasts of his heart's desire; He blesses the greedy and renounces the Lord.
106. Psalm 10:4 The wicked in his proud countenance does not seek God; God is in none of his thoughts.
107. Psalm 10:5 His ways are always prospering; Your judgments are far above, out of his sight; As for all his enemies, he sneers at them.
108. Psalm 10:6 He has said in his heart, "I shall not be moved; I shall never be in adversity."
109. Psalm 10:7 His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and oppression; Under his tongue is trouble and iniquity.
110. Psalm 10:8 He sits in the lurking places of the villages; In the secret places he murders the innocent; His eyes are secretly fixed on the helpless.
111. Psalm 10:9 He lies in wait secretly, as a lion in his den; He lies in wait to catch the poor; He catches the poor when he draws him into his net.
112. Psalm 10:10 So he crouches, he lies low, That the helpless may fall by his strength.
113. Psalm 10:11 He has said in his heart, "God has forgotten; He hides His face; He will never see."
114. Psalm 10:12 Arise, O Lord! O God, lift up Your hand! Do not forget the humble.
115. Psalm 10:13 Why do the wicked renounce God? He has said in his heart, "You will not require an account."
116. Psalm 10:14 But You have seen, for You observe trouble and grief, To repay it by Your hand. The helpless commits himself to You; You are the helper of the fatherless.
117. Psalm 10:15 Break the arm of the wicked and the evil man; Seek out his wickedness until You find none.
118. Psalm 10:16 The Lord is King forever and ever; The nations have perished out of His land.
119. Psalm 10:17 Lord, You have heard the desire of the humble; You will prepare their heart; You will cause Your ear to hear,
120. Psalm 10:18 To do justice to the fatherless and the oppressed, That the man of the earth may oppress no more.

Psalm 11

121. Psalm 11:1 In the Lord I put my trust; How can you say to my soul, "Flee as a bird to your mountain"?
122. Psalm 11:2 For look! The wicked bend their bow, They make ready their arrow on the string, That they may shoot secretly at the upright in heart.
123. Psalm 11:3 If the foundations are destroyed, What can the righteous do?
124. Psalm 11:4 The Lord is in His holy temple, The Lord's throne is in heaven; His eyes behold, His eyelids test the sons of men.
125. Psalm 11:5 The Lord tests the righteous, But the wicked and the one who loves violence His soul hates.
126. Psalm 11:6 Upon the wicked He will rain coals; Fire and brimstone and a burning wind Shall be the portion of their cup.
127. Psalm 11:7 For the Lord is righteous, He loves righteousness; His countenance beholds the upright.

Psalm 12

128. Psalm 12:1 Help, Lord, for the godly man ceases! For the faithful disappear from among the sons of men.
129. Psalm 12:2 They speak idly everyone with his neighbor; With flattering lips and a double heart they speak.
130. Psalm 12:3 May the Lord cut off all flattering lips, And the tongue that speaks proud things,
131. Psalm 12:4 Who have said, "With our tongue we will prevail; Our lips are our own; Who is lord over us?"
132. Psalm 12:5 "For the oppression of the poor, for the sighing of the needy, Now I will arise," says the Lord; "I will set him in the safety for which he yearns."
133. Psalm 12:6 The words of the Lord are pure words, Like silver tried in a furnace of earth, Purified seven times.
134. Psalm 12:7 You shall keep them, O Lord, You shall preserve them from this generation forever.
135. Psalm 12:8 The wicked prowl on every side, When vileness is exalted among the sons of men.

Psalm 13

136. Psalm 13:1 How long, O Lord? Will You forget me forever? How long will You hide Your face from me?
137. Psalm 13:2 How long shall I take counsel in my soul, Having sorrow in my heart daily? How long will my enemy be exalted over me?
138. Psalm 13:3 Consider and hear me, O Lord my God; Enlighten my eyes, Lest I sleep the sleep of death;
139. Psalm 13:4 Lest my enemy say, "I have prevailed against him"; Lest those who trouble me rejoice when I am moved.
140. Psalm 13:5 But I have trusted in Your mercy; My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation.
141. Psalm 13:6 I will sing to the Lord, Because He has dealt bountifully with me.

Psalm 14

142. Psalm 14:1 The fool has said in his heart, "There is no God." They are corrupt, They have done abominable works, There is none who does good.
143. Psalm 14:2 The Lord looks down from heaven upon the children of men, To see if there are any who understand, who seek God.
144. Psalm 14:3 They have all turned aside, They have together become corrupt; There is none who does good, No, not one.
145. Psalm 14:4 Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge, Who eat up my people as they eat bread, And do not call on the Lord?
146. Psalm 14:5 There they are in great fear, For God is with the generation of the righteous.
147. Psalm 14:6 You shame the counsel of the poor, But the Lord is his refuge.
148. Psalm 14:7 Oh, that the salvation of Israel would come out of Zion! When the Lord brings back the captivity of His people, Let Jacob rejoice and Israel be glad.

Psalm 15

149. Psalm 15:1 Lord, who may abide in Your tabernacle? Who may dwell in Your holy hill?
150. Psalm 15:2 He who walks uprightly, And works righteousness, And speaks the truth in his heart;
151. Psalm 15:3 He who does not backbite with his tongue, Nor does evil to his neighbor, Nor does he take up a reproach against his friend;

152. Psalm 15:4 In whose eyes a vile person is despised, But he honors those who fear the Lord; He who swears to his own hurt and does not change;
153. Psalm 15:5 He who does not put out his money at usury, Nor does he take a bribe against the innocent. He who does these things shall never be moved.

Psalm 16

154. Psalm 16:1 Preserve me, O God, for in You I put my trust.
155. Psalm 16:2 O my soul, you have said to the Lord, "You are my Lord, My goodness is nothing apart from You."
156. Psalm 16:3 As for the saints who are on the earth, "They are the excellent ones, in whom is all my delight."
157. Psalm 16:4 Their sorrows shall be multiplied who hasten after another god; Their drink offerings of blood I will not offer, Nor take up their names on my lips.
158. Psalm 16:5 O Lord, You are the portion of my inheritance and my cup; You maintain my lot.
159. Psalm 16:6 The lines have fallen to me in pleasant places; Yes, I have a good inheritance.
160. Psalm 16:7 I will bless the Lord who has given me counsel; My heart also instructs me in the night seasons.
161. Psalm 16:8 I have set the Lord always before me; Because He is at my right hand I shall not be moved.
162. Psalm 16:9 Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; My flesh also will rest in hope.
163. Psalm 16:10 For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.
164. Psalm 16:11 You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore

Psalm 17

165. Psalm 17:1 Hear a just cause, O Lord, Attend to my cry; Give ear to my prayer which is not from deceitful lips.
166. Psalm 17:2 Let my vindication come from Your presence; Let Your eyes look on the things that are upright.
167. Psalm 17:3 You have tested my heart; You have visited me in the night; You have tried me and have found nothing; I have purposed that my mouth shall not transgress.
168. Psalm 17:4 Concerning the works of men, By the word of Your lips, I have kept away from the paths of the destroyer.
169. Psalm 17:5 Uphold my steps in Your paths, That my footsteps may not slip.
170. Psalm 17:6 I have called upon You, for You will hear me, O God; Incline Your ear to me, and hear my speech.
171. Psalm 17:7 Show Your marvelous lovingkindness by Your right hand, O You who save those who trust in You From those who rise up against them.
172. Psalm 17:8 Keep me as the apple of Your eye; Hide me under the shadow of Your wings,
173. Psalm 17:9 From the wicked who oppress me, From my deadly enemies who surround me.
174. Psalm 17:10 They have closed up their fat hearts; With their mouths they speak proudly.
175. Psalm 17:11 They have now surrounded us in our steps; They have set their eyes, crouching down to the earth,
176. Psalm 17:12 As a lion is eager to tear his prey, And like a young lion lurking in secret places.
177. Psalm 17:13 Arise, O Lord, Confront him, cast him down; Deliver my life from the wicked with Your sword,

178. Psalm 17:14 With Your hand from men, O Lord, From men of the world who have their portion in this life, And whose belly You fill with Your hidden treasure. They are satisfied with children, And leave the rest of their possession for their babes.
179. Psalm 17:15 As for me, I will see Your face in righteousness; I shall be satisfied when I awake in Your likeness.

Psalm 18

180. Psalm 18:1 I will love You, O Lord, my strength.
181. Psalm 18:2 The Lord is my rock and my fortress and my deliverer; My God, my strength, in whom I will trust; My shield and the horn of my salvation, my stronghold.
182. Psalm 18:3 I will call upon the Lord, who is worthy to be praised; So shall I be saved from my enemies.
183. Psalm 18:4 The pangs of death surrounded me, And the floods of ungodliness made me afraid.
184. Psalm 18:5 The sorrows of Sheol surrounded me; The snares of death confronted me.
185. Psalm 18:6 In my distress I called upon the Lord, And cried out to my God; He heard my voice from His temple, And my cry came before Him, even to His ears.
186. Psalm 18:7 Then the earth shook and trembled; The foundations of the hills also quaked and were shaken, Because He was angry.
187. Psalm 18:8 Smoke went up from His nostrils, And devouring fire from His mouth; Coals were kindled by it.
188. Psalm 18:9 He bowed the heavens also, and came down With darkness under His feet.
189. Psalm 18:10 And He rode upon a cherub, and flew; He flew upon the wings of the wind.
190. Psalm 18:11 He made darkness His secret place; His canopy around Him was dark waters And thick clouds of the skies.
191. Psalm 18:12 From the brightness before Him, His thick clouds passed with hailstones and coals of fire.
192. Psalm 18:13 The Lord thundered from heaven, And the Most High uttered His voice, Hailstones and coals of fire.
193. Psalm 18:14 He sent out His arrows and scattered the foe, Lightnings in abundance, and He vanquished them.
194. Psalm 18:15 Then the channels of the sea were seen, The foundations of the world were uncovered At Your rebuke, O Lord, At the blast of the breath of Your nostrils.
195. Psalm 18:16 He sent from above, He took me; He drew me out of many waters.
196. Psalm 18:17 He delivered me from my strong enemy, From those who hated me, For they were too strong for me.
197. Psalm 18:18 They confronted me in the day of my calamity, But the Lord was my support.
198. Psalm 18:19 He also brought me out into a broad place; He delivered me because He delighted in me.
199. Psalm 18:20 The Lord rewarded me according to my righteousness; According to the cleanness of my hands He has recompensed me.
200. Psalm 18:21 For I have kept the ways of the Lord, And have not wickedly departed from my God.
201. Psalm 18:22 For all His judgments were before me, And I did not put away His statutes from me.
202. Psalm 18:23 I was also blameless before Him, And I kept myself from my iniquity.
203. Psalm 18:24 Therefore the Lord has recompensed me according to my righteousness, According to the cleanness of my hands in His sight.

204. Psalm 18:25 With the merciful You will show Yourself merciful; With a blameless man You will show Yourself blameless;
205. Psalm 18:26 With the pure You will show Yourself pure; And with the devious You will show Yourself shrewd.
206. Psalm 18:27 For You will save the humble people, But will bring down haughty looks.
207. Psalm 18:28 For You will light my lamp; The Lord my God will enlighten my darkness.
208. Psalm 18:29 For by You I can run against a troop, By my God I can leap over a wall.
209. Psalm 18:30 As for God, His way is perfect; The word of the Lord is proven; He is a shield to all who trust in Him.
210. Psalm 18:31 For who is God, except the Lord? And who is a rock, except our God?
211. Psalm 18:32 It is God who arms me with strength, And makes my way perfect.
212. Psalm 18:33 He makes my feet like the feet of deer, And sets me on my high places.
213. Psalm 18:34 He teaches my hands to make war, So that my arms can bend a bow of bronze.
214. Psalm 18:35 You have also given me the shield of Your salvation; Your right hand has held me up, Your gentleness has made me great.
215. Psalm 18:36 You enlarged my path under me, So my feet did not slip.
216. Psalm 18:37 I have pursued my enemies and overtaken them; Neither did I turn back again till they were destroyed.
217. Psalm 18:38 I have wounded them, So that they could not rise; They have fallen under my feet.
218. Psalm 18:39 For You have armed me with strength for the battle; You have subdued under me those who rose up against me.
219. Psalm 18:40 You have also given me the necks of my enemies, So that I destroyed those who hated me.
220. Psalm 18:41 They cried out, but there was none to save; Even to the Lord, but He did not answer them.
221. Psalm 18:42 Then I beat them as fine as the dust before the wind; I cast them out like dirt in the streets.
222. Psalm 18:43 You have delivered me from the strivings of the people; You have made me the head of the nations; A people I have not known shall serve me.
223. Psalm 18:44 As soon as they hear of me they obey me; The foreigners submit to me.
224. Psalm 18:45 The foreigners fade away, And come frightened from their hideouts.
225. Psalm 18:46 The Lord lives! Blessed be my Rock! Let the God of my salvation be exalted

238. Psalm 19:9 The fear of the Lord is clean, enduring forever; The judgments of the Lord are true and righteous altogether.
239. Psalm 19:10 More to be desired are they than gold, Yea, than much fine gold; Sweeter also than honey and the honeycomb.
240. Psalm 19:11 Moreover by them Your servant is warned, And in keeping them there is great reward.

273. Psalm 22:8 "He trusted in the Lord, let Him rescue Him; Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!"
274. Psalm 22:9 But You are He who took Me out of the womb; You made Me trust while on My mother's breasts.
275. Psalm 22:10 I was cast upon You from birth. From My mother's womb You have been My God.
276. Psalm 22:11 Be not far from Me, For trouble is near; For there is none to help.
277. Psalm 22:12 Many bulls have surrounded Me; Strong bulls of Bashan have encircled Me.
278. Psalm 22:13 They gape at Me with their mouths, Like a raging and roaring lion.
279. Psalm 22:14 I am poured out like water, And all My bones are out of joint; My heart is like wax; It has melted within Me.
280. Psalm 22:15 My strength is dried up like a potsherd, And My tongue clings to My jaws; You have brought Me to the dust of death.
281. Psalm 22:16 For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet;
282. Psalm 22:17 I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me.
283. Psalm 22:18 They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots.
284. Psalm 22:19 But You, O Lord, do not be far from Me; O My Strength, hasten to help Me!
285. Psalm 22:20 Deliver Me from the sword, My precious life from the power of the dog.
286. Psalm 22:21 Save Me from the lion's mouth And from the horns of the wild oxen! You have answered Me.

287. Psalm 22:22 I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will praise You.
288. Psalm 22:23 You who fear the Lord, praise Him! All you descendants of Jacob, glorify Him, And fear Him, all you offspring of Israel!
289. Psalm 22:24 For He has not despised nor abhorred the affliction of the afflicted; Nor has He hidden His face from Him; But when He cried to Him, He heard.

345. Psalm 26:11 But as for me, I will walk in my integrity; Redeem me and be merciful to me.
346. Psalm 26:12 My foot stands in an even place; In the congregations I will bless the Lord.

Psalm 27

377. Psalm 29:8 The voice of the Lord shakes the wilderness; The Lord shakes the Wilderness of Kadesh.
378. Psalm 29:9 The voice of the Lord makes the deer give birth, And strips the forests bare; And in His temple everyone says, "Glory!"
379. Psalm 29:10 The Lord sat enthroned at the Flood, And the Lord sits as King forever.
380. Psalm 29:11 The Lord will give strength to His people; The Lord will bless His people with peace.

Psalm 30

381. Psalm 30:1 I will extol You, O Lord, for You have lifted me up, And have not let my foes rejoice over me.
382. Psalm 30:2 O Lord my God, I cried out to You, And You healed me.

390. Psalm 30:10 Hear, O Lord, and have mercy on me; Lord, be my helper!"
391. Psalm 30:11 You have turned for me my mourning into dancing; You have put off my sackcloth and clothed me with gladness,
392. Psalm 30:12 To the end that my glory may sing praise to You and not be silent. O Lord my God, I will give thanks to You forever.

Psalm 31

393. Psalm 31:1 In You, O Lord, I put my trust; Let me never be ashamed; Deliver me in Your righteousness.
394. Psalm 31:2 Bow down Your ear to me, Deliver me speedily; Be my rock of refuge, A fortress of defense to save me.

400. Psalm 31:8 And have not shut me up into the hand of the enemy; You have set my feet in a wide place.

402. Psalm 31:10 For my life is spent with grief, And my years with sighing; My strength fails because of my iniquity, And my bones waste away.
403. Psalm 31:11 I am a reproach among all my enemies, But especially among my neighbors, And am repulsive to my acquaintances; Those who see me outside flee from me.
404. Psalm 31:12 I am forgotten like a dead man, out of mind; I am like a broken vessel.
405. Psalm 31:13 For I hear the slander of many; Fear is on every side; While they take counsel together against me, They scheme to take away my life.
406. Psalm 31:14 But as for me, I trust in You, O Lord; I say, "You are my God."
407. Psalm 31:15 My times are in Your hand; Deliver me from the hand of my enemies, And from those who persecute me.
408. Psalm 31:16 Make Your face shine upon Your servant; Save me for Your mercies' sake.
409. Psalm 31:17 Do not let me be ashamed, O Lord, for I have called upon You; Let the wicked be ashamed; Let them be silent in the grave.
410. Psalm 31:18 Let the lying lips be put to silence, Which speak insolent things proudly and contemptuously against the righteous.
411. Psalm 31:19 Oh, how great is Your goodness, Which You have laid up for those who fear You, Which You have prepared for those who trust in You In the presence of the sons of men!
412. Psalm 31:20 You shall hide them in the secret place of Your presence From the plots of man; You shall keep them secretly in a pavilion From the strife of tongues.

447. Psalm 33:20 Our soul waits for the Lord; He is our help and our shield.

456. Psalm 34:7 The angel of the Lord encamps all around those who fear Him, And delivers them.
457. Psalm 34:8 Oh, taste and see that the Lord is good; Blessed is the man who trusts in Him!
458. Psalm 34:9 Oh, fear the Lord, you His saints! There is no want to those who fear Him.
459. Psalm 34:10 The young lions lack and suffer hunger; But those who seek the Lord shall not lack any good thing.
460. Psalm 34:11 Come, you children, listen to me; I will teach you the fear of the Lord.
461. Psalm 34:12 Who is the man who desires life, And loves many days, that he may see good?
462. Psalm 34:13 Keep your tongue from evil, And your lips from speaking deceit.
463. Psalm 34:14 Depart from evil and do good; Seek peace and pursue it.
464. Psalm 34:15 The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous, And His ears are open to their cry.
465. Psalm 34:16 The face of the Lord is against those who do evil, To cut off the remembrance of them from the earth.
466. Psalm 34:17 The righteous cry out, and the Lord hears, And delivers them out of all their troubles.
467. Psalm 34:18 The Lord is near to those who have a broken heart, And saves such as have a contrite spirit.
468. Psalm 34:19 Many are the afflictions of the righteous, But the Lord delivers him out of them all.
469. Psalm 34:20 He guards all his bones; Not one of them is broken.
470. Psalm 34:21 Evil shall slay the wicked, And those who hate the righteous shall be condemned.
471. Psalm 34:22 The Lord redeems the soul of His servants, And none of those who trust in Him shall be condemned.

Psalm 35

472. Psalm 35:1 Plead my cause, O Lord, with those who strive with me; Fight against those who fight against me.
473. Psalm 35:2 Take hold of shield and buckler, And stand up for my help.
474. Psalm 35:3 Also draw out the spear, And stop those who pursue me. Say to my soul, "I am your salvation."
475. Psalm 35:4 Let those be put to shame and brought to dishonor Who seek after my life; Let those be turned back and brought to confusion Who plot my hurt.
476. Psalm 35:5 Let them be like chaff before the wind, And let the angel of the Lord chase them.

477. Psalm 35:6 Let their way be dark and slippery, And let the angel of the Lord pursue them.
478. Psalm 35:7 For without cause they have hidden their net for me in a pit, Which they have dug without cause for my life.
479. Psalm 35:8 Let destruction come upon him unexpectedly, And let his net that he has hidden catch himself; Into that very destruction let him fall.
480. Psalm 35:9 And my soul shall be joyful in the Lord; It shall rejoice in His salvation.
481. Psalm 35:10 All my bones shall say, "Lord, who is like You, Delivering the poor from him who is too strong for him, Yes, the poor and the needy from him who plunders him?"
482. Psalm 35:11 Fierce witnesses rise up; They ask me things that I do not know.
483. Psalm 35:12 They reward me evil for good, To the sorrow of my soul.
484. Psalm 35:13 But as for me, when they were sick, My clothing was sackcloth; I humbled myself with fasting; And my prayer would return to my own heart.
485. Psalm 35:14 I paced about as though he were my friend or brother; I bowed down heavily, as one who mourns for his mother.
486. Psalm 35:15 But in my adversity they rejoiced And gathered together; Attackers gathered against me, And I did not know it; They tore at me and did not cease;
487. Psalm 35:16 With ungodly mockers at feasts They gnashed at me with their teeth.
488. Psalm 35:17 Lord, how long will You look on? Rescue me from their destructions, My precious life from the lions.
489. Psalm 35:18 I will give You thanks in the great assembly; I will praise You among many people.
490. Psalm 35:19 Let them not rejoice over me who are wrongfully my enemies; Nor let them wink with the eye who hate me without a cause.
491. Psalm 35:20 For they do not speak peace, But they devise deceitful matters Against the quiet ones in the land.
492. Psalm 35:21 They also opened their mouth wide against me, And said, "Aha, aha! Our eyes have seen it."
493. Psalm 35:22 This You have seen, O Lord; Do not keep silence. O Lord, do not be far from me.
494. Psalm 35:23 Stir up Yourself, and awake to my vindication, To my cause, my God and my Lord.
495. Psalm 35:24 Vindicate me, O Lord my God, according to Your righteousness; And let them not rejoice over me.
496. Psalm 35:25 Let them not say in their hearts, "Ah, so we would have it!" Let them not say, "We have swallowed him up."
497. Psalm 35:26 Let them be ashamed and brought to mutual confusion Who rejoice at my hurt; Let them be clothed with shame and dishonor Who exalt themselves against me.
498. Psalm 35:27 Let them shout for joy and be glad, Who favor my righteous cause; And let them say continually, "Let the Lord be magnified, Who has pleasure in the prosperity of His servant."
499. Psalm 35:28 And my tongue shall speak of Your righteousness And of Your praise all the day long.

500. Psalm 36:1 An oracle within my heart concerning the transgression of the wicked: There is no fear of God before his eyes.
501. Psalm 36:2 For he flatters himself in his own eyes, When he finds out his iniquity and when he hates.
502. Psalm 36:3 The words of his mouth are wickedness and deceit; He has ceased to be wise and to do good.
503. Psalm 36:4 He devises wickedness on his bed; He sets himself in a way that is not good; He does not abhor evil.
504. Psalm 36:5 Your mercy, O Lord, is in the heavens; Your faithfulness reaches to the clouds.
505. Psalm 36:6 Your righteousness is like the great mountains; Your judgments are a great deep; O Lord, You preserve man and beast.
506. Psalm 36:7 How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore the children of men put their trust under the shadow of Your wings.
507. Psalm 36:8 They are abundantly satisfied with the fullness of Your house, And You give them drink from the river of Your pleasures.
508. Psalm 36:9 For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light.
509. Psalm 36:10 Oh, continue Your lovingkindness to those who know You, And Your righteousness to the upright in heart.
510. Psalm 36:11 Let not the foot of pride come against me, And let not the hand of the wicked drive me away.
511. Psalm 36:12 There the workers of iniquity have fallen; They have been cast down and are not able to rise.

Psalm 37

512. Psalm 37:1 Do not fret because of evildoers, Nor be envious of the workers of iniquity.
513. Psalm 37:2 For they shall soon be cut down like the grass, And wither as the green herb.
514. Psalm 37:3 Trust in the Lord, and do good; Dwell in the land, and feed on His faithfulness.
515. Psalm 37:4 Delight yourself also in the Lord, And He shall give you the desires of your heart.
516. Psalm 37:5 Commit your way to the Lord, Trust also in Him, And He shall bring it to pass.
517. Psalm 37:6 He shall bring forth your righteousness as the light, And your justice as the noonday.
518. Psalm 37:7 Rest in the Lord, and wait patiently for Him; Do not fret because of him who prospers in his way, Because of the man who brings wicked schemes to pass.
519. Psalm 37:8 Cease from anger, and forsake wrath; Do not fret--it only causes harm. 9 For evildoers shall be cut off; But those who wait on the Lord, They shall inherit the earth.
520. Psalm 37:9 For evildoers shall be cut off; But those who wait on the Lord, They shall inherit the earth.
521. Psalm 37:10 For yet a little while and the wicked shall be no more; Indeed, you will look carefully for his place, But it shall be no more.
522. Psalm 37:11 But the meek shall inherit the earth, And shall delight themselves in the abundance of peace.
523. Psalm 37:12 The wicked plots against the just, And gnashes at him with his teeth.
524. Psalm 37:13 The Lord laughs at him, For He sees that his day is coming.
525. Psalm 37:14 The wicked have drawn the sword And have bent their bow, To cast down the poor and needy, To slay those who are of upright conduct.
526. Psalm 37:15 Their sword shall enter their own heart, And their bows shall be broken.
527. Psalm 37:16 A little that a righteous man has Is better than the riches of many wicked.

528. Psalm 37:17 For the arms of the wicked shall be broken, But the Lord upholds the righteous.
529. Psalm 37:18 The Lord knows the days of the upright, And their inheritance shall be forever.
530. Psalm 37:19 They shall not be ashamed in the evil time, And in the days of famine they shall be satisfied.
531. Psalm 37:20 But the wicked shall perish; And the enemies of the Lord, Like the splendor of the meadows, shall vanish. Into smoke they shall vanish away.
532. Psalm 37:21 The wicked borrows and does not repay, But the righteous shows mercy and gives.
533. Psalm 37:22 For those blessed by Him shall inherit the earth, But those cursed by Him shall be cut off.
534. Psalm 37:23 The steps of a good man are ordered by the Lord, And He delights in his way.
535. Psalm 37:24 Though he fall, he shall not be utterly cast down; For the Lord upholds him with His hand.
536. Psalm 37:25 I have been young, and now am old; Yet I have not seen the righteous forsaken, Nor his descendants begging bread.
537. Psalm 37:26 He is ever merciful, and lends; And his descendants are blessed.
538. Psalm 37:27 Depart from evil, and do good; And dwell forevermore.
539. Psalm 37:28 For the Lord loves justice, And does not forsake His saints; They are preserved forever, But the descendants of the wicked shall be cut off.
540. Psalm 37:29 The righteous shall inherit the land, And dwell in it forever.
541. Psalm 37:30 The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, And his tongue talks of justice.
542. Psalm 37:31 The law of his God is in his heart; None of his steps shall slide.
543. Psalm 37:32 The wicked watches the righteous, And seeks to slay him.
544. Psalm 37:33 The Lord will not leave him in his hand, Nor condemn him when he is judged.
545. Psalm 37:34 Wait on the Lord, And keep His way, And He shall exalt you to inherit the land; When the wicked are cut off, you shall see it.
546. Psalm 37:35 I have seen the wicked in great power, And spreading himself like a native green tree.
547. Psalm 37:36 Yet he passed away, and behold, he was no more; Indeed I sought him, but he could not be found.
548. Psalm 37:37 Mark the blameless man, and observe the upright; For the future of that man is peace.
549. Psalm 37:38 But the transgressors shall be destroyed together; The future of the wicked shall be cut off.
550. Psalm 37:39 But the salvation of the righteous is from the Lord; He is their strength in the time of trouble.
551. Psalm 37:40 And the Lord shall help them and deliver them; He shall deliver them from the wicked, And save them, Because they trust in Him.

Psalm 38

552. Psalm 38:1 O Lord, do not rebuke me in Your wrath, Nor chasten me in Your hot displeasure!
553. Psalm 38:2 For Your arrows pierce me deeply, And Your hand presses me down.
554. Psalm 38:3 There is no soundness in my flesh Because of Your anger, Nor any health in my bones Because of my sin.
555. Psalm 38:4 For my iniquities have gone over my head; Like a heavy burden they are too heavy for me.
556. Psalm 38:5 My wounds are foul and festering Because of my foolishness.
557. Psalm 38:6 I am troubled, I am bowed down greatly; I go mourning all the day long.
558. Psalm 38:7 For my loins are full of inflammation, And there is no soundness in my flesh.

559. Psalm 38:8 I am feeble and severely broken; I groan because of the turmoil of my heart.
560. Psalm 38:9 Lord, all my desire is before You; And my sighing is not hidden from You.
561. Psalm 38:10 My heart pants, my strength fails me; As for the light of my eyes, it also has gone from me.
562. Psalm 38:11 My loved ones and my friends stand aloof from my plague, And my relatives stand afar off.
563. Psalm 38:12 Those also who seek my life lay snares for me; Those who seek my hurt speak of destruction, And plan deception all the day long.
564. Psalm 38:13 But I, like a deaf man, do not hear; And I am like a mute who does not open his mouth.
565. Psalm 38:14 Thus I am like a man who does not hear, And in whose mouth is no response.
566. Psalm 38:15 For in You, O Lord, I hope; You will hear, O Lord my God.
567. Psalm 38:16 For I said, "Hear me, lest they rejoice over me, Lest, when my foot slips, they exalt themselves against me."
568. Psalm 38:17 For I am ready to fall, And my sorrow is continually before me.
569. Psalm 38:18 For I will declare my iniquity; I will be in anguish over my sin.
570. Psalm 38:19 But my enemies are vigorous, and they are strong; And those who hate me wrongfully have multiplied.
571. Psalm 38:20 Those also who render evil for good, They are my adversaries, because I follow what is good.
572. Psalm 38:21 Do not forsake me, O Lord; O my God, be not far from me!
573. Psalm 38:22 Make haste to help me, O Lord, my salvation!

Psalm 39

574. Psalm 39:1 I said, "I will guard my ways, Lest I sin with my tongue; I will restrain my mouth with a muzzle, While the wicked are before me."
575. Psalm 39:2 I was mute with silence, I held my peace even from good; And my sorrow was stirred up.
576. Psalm 39:3 My heart was hot within me; While I was musing, the fire burned. Then I spoke with my tongue:
577. Psalm 39:4 "Lord, make me to know my end, And what is the measure of my days, That I may know how frail I am.
578. Psalm 39:5 Indeed, You have made my days as handbreadths, And my age is as nothing before You; Certainly every man at his best state is but vapor.
579. Psalm 39:6 Surely every man walks about like a shadow; Surely they busy themselves in vain; He heaps up riches, And does not know who will gather them.
580. Psalm 39:7 "And now, Lord, what do I wait for? My hope is in You.
581. Psalm 39:8 Deliver me from all my transgressions; Do not make me the reproach of the foolish.
582. Psalm 39:9 I was mute, I did not open my mouth, Because it was You who did it.
583. Psalm 39:10 Remove Your plague from me; I am consumed by the blow of Your hand.
584. Psalm 39:11 When with rebukes You correct man for iniquity, You make his beauty melt away like a moth; Surely every man is vapor.
585. Psalm 39:12 "Hear my prayer, O Lord, And give ear to my cry; Do not be silent at my tears; For I am a stranger with You, A sojourner, as all my fathers were.
586. Psalm 39:13 Remove Your gaze from me, that I may regain strength, Before I go away and am no more."

Psalm 40

587. Psalm 40:1 I waited patiently for the Lord; And He inclined to me, And heard my cry.
588. Psalm 40:2 He also brought me up out of a horrible pit, Out of the miry clay, And set my feet upon a rock, And established my steps.
589. Psalm 40:3 He has put a new song in my mouth-- Praise to our God; Many will see it and fear, And will trust in the Lord.
590. Psalm 40:4 Blessed is that man who makes the Lord his trust, And does not respect the proud, nor such as turn aside to lies.
591. Psalm 40:5 Many, O Lord my God, are Your wonderful works Which You have done; And Your thoughts toward us Cannot be recounted to You in order; If I would declare and speak of them, They are more than can be numbered.
592. Psalm 40:6 Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; My ears You have opened. Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require.
593. Psalm 40:7 Then I said, "Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me.
594. Psalm 40:8 I delight to do Your will, O my God, And Your law is within my heart."
595. Psalm 40:9 I have proclaimed the good news of righteousness In the great assembly; Indeed, I do not restrain my lips, O Lord, You Yourself know.
596. Psalm 40:10 I have not hidden Your righteousness within my heart; I have declared Your faithfulness and Your salvation; I have not concealed Your lovingkindness and Your truth From the great assembly.
597. Psalm 40:11 Do not withhold Your tender mercies from me, O Lord; Let Your lovingkindness and Your truth continually preserve me.
598. Psalm 40:12 For innumerable evils have surrounded me; My iniquities have overtaken me, so that I am not able to look up; They are more than the hairs of my head; Therefore my heart fails me.
599. Psalm 40:13 Be pleased, O Lord, to deliver me; O Lord, make haste to help me!
600. Psalm 40:14 Let them be ashamed and brought to mutual confusion Who seek to destroy my life; Let them be driven backward and brought to dishonor Who wish me evil.
601. Psalm 40:15 Let them be confounded because of their shame, Who say to me, "Aha, aha!"
602. Psalm 40:16 Let all those who seek You rejoice and be glad in You; Let such as love Your salvation say continually, "The Lord be magnified!"
603. Psalm 40:17 But I am poor and needy; Yet the Lord thinks upon me. You are my help and my deliverer; Do not delay, O my God.

Psalm 41

604. Psalm 41:1 Blessed is he who considers the poor; The Lord will deliver him in time of trouble.
605. Psalm 41:2 The Lord will preserve him and keep him alive, And he will be blessed on the earth; You will not deliver him to the will of his enemies.
606. Psalm 41:3 The Lord will strengthen him on his bed of illness; You will sustain him on his sickbed.
607. Psalm 41:4 I said, "Lord, be merciful to me; Heal my soul, for I have sinned against You."
608. Psalm 41:5 My enemies speak evil of me: "When will he die, and his name perish?"

609. Psalm 41:6 And if he comes to see me, he speaks lies; His heart gathers iniquity to itself; When he goes out, he tells it.
610. Psalm 41:7 All who hate me whisper together against me; Against me they devise my hurt.
611. Psalm 41:8 "An evil disease," they say, "clings to him. And now that he lies down, he will rise up no more."
612. Psalm 41:9 Even my own familiar friend in whom I trusted, Who ate my bread, Has lifted up his heel against me.
613. Psalm 41:10 But You, O Lord, be merciful to me, and raise me up, That I may repay them.
614. Psalm 41:11 By this I know that You are well pleased with me, Because my enemy does not triumph over me.
615. Psalm 41:12 As for me, You uphold me in my integrity, And set me before Your face forever.
616. Psalm 41:13 Blessed be the Lord God of Israel From everlasting to everlasting! Amen and Amen.

Psalm 42

617. Psalm 42:1 As the deer pants for the water brooks, So pants my soul for You, O God.
618. Psalm 42:2 My soul thirsts for God, for the living God. When shall I come and appear before God?
619. Psalm 42:3 My tears have been my food day and night, While they continually say to me, "Where is your God?"
620. Psalm 42:4 When I remember these things, I pour out my soul within me. For I used to go with the multitude; I went with them to the house of God, With the voice of joy and praise, With a multitude that kept a pilgrim feast.
621. Psalm 42:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God, for I shall yet praise Him For the help of His countenance.
622. Psalm 42:6 O my God, my soul is cast down within me; Therefore I will remember You from the land of the Jordan, And from the heights of Hermon, From the Hill Mizar.
623. Psalm 42:7 Deep calls unto deep at the noise of Your waterfalls; All Your waves and billows have gone over me.
624. Psalm 42:8 The Lord will command His lovingkindness in the daytime, And in the night His song shall be with me-- A prayer to the God of my life.
625. Psalm 42:9 I will say to God my Rock, "Why have You forgotten me? Why do I go mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?"
626. Psalm 42:10 As with a breaking of my bones, My enemies reproach me, While they say to me all day long, "Where is your God?"
627. Psalm 42:11 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God; For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.

Psalm 43

628. Psalm 43:1 Vindicate me, O God, And plead my cause against an ungodly nation; Oh, deliver me from the deceitful and unjust man!
629. Psalm 43:2 For You are the God of my strength; Why do You cast me off? Why do I go mourning because of the oppression of the enemy?
630. Psalm 43:3 Oh, send out Your light and Your truth! Let them lead me; Let them bring me to Your holy hill And to Your tabernacle.

631. Psalm 43:4 Then I will go to the altar of God, To God my exceeding joy; And on the harp I will praise You, O God, my God.
632. Psalm 43:5 Why are you cast down, O my soul? And why are you disquieted within me? Hope in God; For I shall yet praise Him, The help of my countenance and my God.

Psalm 44

633. Psalm 44:1 We have heard with our ears, O God, Our fathers have told us, The deeds You did in their days, In days of old:
634. Psalm 44:2 You drove out the nations with Your hand, But them You planted; You afflicted the peoples, and cast them out.
635. Psalm 44:3 For they did not gain possession of the land by their own sword, Nor did their own arm save them; But it was Your right hand, Your arm, and the light of Your countenance, Because You favored them.
636. Psalm 44:4 You are my King, O God; Command victories for Jacob.
637. Psalm 44:5 Through You we will push down our enemies; Through Your name we will trample those who rise up against us.
638. Psalm 44:6 For I will not trust in my bow, Nor shall my sword save me.
639. Psalm 44:7 But You have saved us from our enemies, And have put to shame those who hated us.
640. Psalm 44:8 In God we boast all day long, And praise Your name forever.
641. Psalm 44:9 But You have cast us off and put us to shame, And You do not go out with our armies
642. Psalm 44:10 You make us turn back from the enemy, And those who hate us have taken spoil for themselves.
643. Psalm 44:11 You have given us up like sheep intended for food, And have scattered us among the nations.
644. Psalm 44:12 You sell Your people for next to nothing, And are not enriched by selling them.
645. Psalm 44:13 You make us a reproach to our neighbors, A scorn and a derision to those all around us.
646. Psalm 44:14 You make us a byword among the nations, A shaking of the head among the peoples.
647. Psalm 44:15 My dishonor is continually before me, And the shame of my face has covered me,
648. Psalm 44:16 Because of the voice of him who reproaches and reviles, Because of the enemy and the avenger.
649. Psalm 44:17 All this has come upon us; But we have not forgotten You, Nor have we dealt falsely with Your covenant.
650. Psalm 44:18 Our heart has not turned back, Nor have our steps departed from Your way;
651. Psalm 44:19 But You have severely broken us in the place of jackals, And covered us with the shadow of death.
652. Psalm 44:20 If we had forgotten the name of our God, Or stretched out our hands to a foreign god,
653. Psalm 44:21 Would not God search this out? For He knows the secrets of the heart.
654. Psalm 44:22 Yet for Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter.
655. Psalm 44:23 Awake! Why do You sleep, O Lord? Arise! Do not cast us off forever.
656. Psalm 44:24 Why do You hide Your face, And forget our affliction and our oppression?
657. Psalm 44:25 For our soul is bowed down to the dust; Our body clings to the ground.
658. Psalm 44:26 Arise for our help, And redeem us for Your mercies' sake.

Psalm 45

659. Psalm 45:1 My heart is overflowing with a good theme; I recite my composition concerning the King; My tongue is the pen of a ready writer.
660. Psalm 45:2 You are fairer than the sons of men; Grace is poured upon Your lips; Therefore God has blessed You forever.
661. Psalm 45:3 Gird Your sword upon Your thigh, O Mighty One, With Your glory and Your majesty.
662. Psalm 45:4 And in Your majesty ride prosperously because of truth, humility, and righteousness; And Your right hand shall teach You awesome things.
663. Psalm 45:5 Your arrows are sharp in the heart of the King's enemies; The peoples fall under You.
664. Psalm 45:6 Your throne, O God, is forever and ever; A scepter of righteousness is the scepter of Your kingdom.
665. Psalm 45:7 You love righteousness and hate wickedness; Therefore God, Your God, has anointed You With the oil of gladness more than Your companions.
666. Psalm 45:8 All Your garments are scented with myrrh and aloes and cassia, Out of the ivory palaces, by which they have made You glad.
667. Psalm 45:9 Kings' daughters are among Your honorable women; At Your right hand stands the queen in gold from Ophir.
668. Psalm 45:10 Listen, O daughter, Consider and incline your ear; Forget your own people also, and your father's house;
669. Psalm 45:11 So the King will greatly desire your beauty; Because He is your Lord, worship Him.
670. Psalm 45:12 And the daughter of Tyre will come with a gift; The rich among the people will seek your favor.
671. Psalm 45:13 The royal daughter is all glorious within the palace; Her clothing is woven with gold.
672. Psalm 45:14 She shall be brought to the King in robes of many colors; The virgins, her companions who follow her, shall be brought to You.
673. Psalm 45:15 With gladness and rejoicing they shall be brought; They shall enter the King's palace.
674. Psalm 45:16 Instead of Your fathers shall be Your sons, Whom You shall make princes in all the earth.
675. Psalm 45:17 I will make Your name to be remembered in all generations; Therefore the people shall praise You forever and ever

Psalm 46

676. Psalm 46:1 God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble.
677. Psalm 46:2 Therefore we will not fear, Even though the earth be removed, And though the mountains be carried into the midst of the sea;
678. Psalm 46:3 Though its waters roar and be troubled, Though the mountains shake with its swelling.
679. Psalm 46:4 There is a river whose streams shall make glad the city of God, The holy place of the tabernacle of the Most High.
680. Psalm 46:5 God is in the midst of her, she shall not be moved; God shall help her, just at the break of dawn.
681. Psalm 46:6 The nations raged, the kingdoms were moved; He uttered His voice, the earth melted.
682. Psalm 46:7 The Lord of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our refuge.
683. Psalm 46:8 Come, behold the works of the Lord, Who has made desolations in the earth.
684. Psalm 46:9 He makes wars cease to the end of the earth; He breaks the bow and cuts the spear in two; He burns the chariot in the fire.

685. Psalm 46:10 Be still, and know that I am God; I will be exalted among the nations, I will be exalted in the earth!
686. Psalm 46:11 The Lord of hosts is with us; The God of Jacob is our refuge.

Psalm 47

687. Psalm 47:1 Oh, clap your hands, all you peoples! Shout to God with the voice of triumph!
688. Psalm 47:2 For the Lord Most High is awesome; He is a great King over all the earth.
689. Psalm 47:3 He will subdue the peoples under us, And the nations under our feet.
690. Psalm 47:4 He will choose our inheritance for us, The excellence of Jacob whom He loves.
691. Psalm 47:5 God has gone up with a shout, The Lord with the sound of a trumpet.
692. Psalm 47:6 Sing praises to God, sing praises! Sing praises to our King, sing praises!
693. Psalm 47:7 For God is the King of all the earth; Sing praises with understanding.
694. Psalm 47:8 God reigns over the nations; God sits on His holy throne.
695. Psalm 47:9 The princes of the people have gathered together, The people of the God of Abraham. For the shields of the earth belong to God; He is greatly exalted.

Psalm 48

696. Psalm 48:1 Great is the Lord, and greatly to be praised In the city of our God, In His holy mountain.
697. Psalm 48:2 Beautiful in elevation, The joy of the whole earth, Is Mount Zion on the sides of the north, The city of the great King.
698. Psalm 48:3 God is in her palaces; He is known as her refuge.
699. Psalm 48:4 For behold, the kings assembled, They passed by together.
700. Psalm 48:5 They saw it, and so they marveled; They were troubled, they hastened away.
701. Psalm 48:6 Fear took hold of them there, And pain, as of a woman in birth pangs,
702. Psalm 48:7 As when You break the ships of Tarshish With an east wind.
703. Psalm 48:8 As we have heard, So we have seen In the city of the Lord of hosts, In the city of our God: God will establish it forever.
704. Psalm 48:9 We have thought, O God, on Your lovingkindness, In the midst of Your temple.
705. Psalm 48:10 According to Your name, O God, So is Your praise to the ends of the earth; Your right hand is full of righteousness.
706. Psalm 48:11 Let Mount Zion rejoice, Let the daughters of Judah be glad, Because of Your judgments.
707. Psalm 48:12 Walk about Zion, And go all around her. Count her towers;
708. Psalm 48:13 Mark well her bulwarks; Consider her palaces; That you may tell it to the generation following.
709. Psalm 48:14 For this is God, Our God forever and ever; He will be our guide Even to death.

Psalm 49

710. Psalm 49:1 Hear this, all peoples; Give ear, all inhabitants of the world,
711. Psalm 49:2 Both low and high, Rich and poor together.
712. Psalm 49:3 My mouth shall speak wisdom, And the meditation of my heart shall give understanding.
713. Psalm 49:4 I will incline my ear to a proverb; I will disclose my dark saying on the harp.

714. Psalm 49:5 Why should I fear in the days of evil, When the iniquity at my heels surrounds me?
715. Psalm 49:6 Those who trust in their wealth And boast in the multitude of their riches,
716. Psalm 49:7 None of them can by any means redeem his brother, Nor give to God a ransom for him--
717. Psalm 49:8 For the redemption of their souls is costly, And it shall cease forever--
718. Psalm 49:9 That he should continue to live eternally, And not see the Pit.
719. Psalm 49:10 For he sees wise men die; Likewise the fool and the senseless person perish, And leave their wealth to others.
720. Psalm 49:11 Their inner thought is that their houses will last forever, Their dwelling places to all generations; They call their lands after their own names.
721. Psalm 49:12 Nevertheless man, though in honor, does not remain; He is like the beasts that perish.
722. Psalm 49:13 This is the way of those who are foolish, And of their posterity who approve their sayings.
723. Psalm 49:14 Like sheep they are laid in the grave; Death shall feed on them; The upright shall have dominion over them in the morning; And their beauty shall be consumed in the grave, far from their dwelling.
724. Psalm 49:15 But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave, For He shall receive me.
725. Psalm 49:16 Do not be afraid when one becomes rich, When the glory of his house is increased;
726. Psalm 49:17 For when he dies he shall carry nothing away; His glory shall not descend after him.
727. Psalm 49:18 Though while he lives he blesses himself (For men will praise you when you do well for yourself),
728. Psalm 49:19 He shall go to the generation of his fathers; They shall never see light.
729. Psalm 49:20 A man who is in honor, yet does not understand, Is like the beasts that perish.

Psalm 50

730. Psalm 50:1 The Mighty One, God the Lord, Has spoken and called the earth From the rising of the sun to its going down.
731. Psalm 50:2 Out of Zion, the perfection of beauty, God will shine forth.
732. Psalm 50:3 Our God shall come, and shall not keep silent; A fire shall devour before Him, And it shall be very tempestuous all around Him.
733. Psalm 50:4 He shall call to the heavens from above, And to the earth, that He may judge His people:
734. Psalm 50:5 "Gather My saints together to Me, Those who have made a covenant with Me by sacrifice."
735. Psalm 50:6 Let the heavens declare His righteousness, For God Himself is Judge.
736. Psalm 50:7 "Hear, O My people, and I will speak, O Israel, and I will testify against you; I am God, your God!
737. Psalm 50:8 I will not rebuke you for your sacrifices Or your burnt offerings, Which are continually before Me.
738. Psalm 50:9 I will not take a bull from your house, Nor goats out of your folds.
739. Psalm 50:10 For every beast of the forest is Mine, And the cattle on a thousand hills.
740. Psalm 50:11 I know all the birds of the mountains, And the wild beasts of the field are Mine.
741. Psalm 50:12 "If I were hungry, I would not tell you; For the world is Mine, and all its fullness.
742. Psalm 50:13 Will I eat the flesh of bulls, Or drink the blood of goats?
743. Psalm 50:14 Offer to God thanksgiving, And pay your vows to the Most High.
744. Psalm 50:15 Call upon Me in the day of trouble; I will deliver you, and you shall glorify Me."
745. Psalm 50:16 But to the wicked God says: "What right have you to declare My statutes, Or take My covenant in your mouth,

746. Psalm 50:17 Seeing you hate instruction And cast My words behind you?
747. Psalm 50:18 When you saw a thief, you consented with him, And have been a partaker with adulterers.
748. Psalm 50:19 You give your mouth to evil, And your tongue frames deceit.
749. Psalm 50:20 You sit and speak against your brother; You slander your own mother's son.
750. Psalm 50:21 These things you have done, and I kept silent; You thought that I was altogether like you; But I will rebuke you, And set them in order before your eyes.
751. Psalm 50:22 "Now consider this, you who forget God, Lest I tear you in pieces, And there be none to deliver:
752. Psalm 50:23 Whoever offers praise glorifies Me; And to him who orders his conduct aright I will show the salvation of God."
